School Supplies List

PLEASE REMEMBER: Parent Orientation is September 2nd, 7:00 p.m. - 8:15 p.m.

All 7th-12th Grade Students

- *2 boxes of Kleenex
(These are to be given to the Homeroom teacher the first day of school.)
- *4 boxes Clorox Wipes – or any brand of disinfectant
(These are to be given to the Homeroom teacher the first day of school.)
- *Book Bag
- *Three-ring binder large enough for 8 subjects
- *Three-ring binder for one subject (3/4”) – for journal
- *Three-ring binder for one subject (3/4”) – for Bible
- *200 sheets of college ruled white, loose-leaf notebook paper
No spiral bound or perforated spiral bound notebooks. No colored paper.
- *4 standard blue or black ballpoint pens
(Absolutely NO gel pens or colored ink pens)
- *4 red ballpoint pens
- *Six (6) #2 pencils

- *Dry erase marker eraser
- *1 pkg. (100) 3x5 index cards (for English class)
- *Combination lock for locker
(Every student will be required to submit their combination to their Homeroom teacher on the first day of school. Students will not be issued a locker without a combination lock.)
- *Clear, plastic water bottle with a snap close lid
(Students are allowed to drink water in class only if they have a clear, plastic water bottle with a snap close lid. Please write the student's name with permanent marker on the water bottle.)
- *White Out Tape (*Liquid White Out is not permitted on the campus.*)
- *Paper Covers for each textbook (no sticky covers, no stretch covers – paper bags are recommended to save costs)
- *1 Flash Drive (please write student's name on this)

All 7th-12th Grade Students

All 7th-12th grade students will be required to purchase an FCS planner/organizer. The teachers have selected an excellent planner, and they will instruct the students in their proper use. The FCS staff believes that learning to be responsible and organized about homework/test assignments is an important factor in academic success. The planner will also be a vital teacher-parent communication tool. *Planners will be available at Parents' Orientation. Each student must have a planner the first day of school. Each planner will cost \$8.*

Spanish or French Students

- *Spanish-English dictionary or French-English dictionary
- *2 pkgs. (100) 3x5 index cards (for Spanish or French class)

History/Bible Students

*1 pkg. (100) index cards

Music Students

*E tuning fork (can be purchased at any music store)

*50 sheets of staff paper

*1 pkg. (50) 3x5 index cards (for music class)

Math/Physics Students

*The following items are required for **all** Math students*

*Compass for drawing circles (must be good quality – purchased for \$3-\$5)

*Protractor

*Ruler with standard and metric

*Graph paper (quadrille ruled)

*150 page spiral bound notebook for classroom notes

Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, Adv. Math, and Physics Students: Students must have a mathematic/scientific calculator in order to complete their classroom work. The calculator should be able to perform inverse operations.

Chemistry Students

*Calculator

*Graph Paper (quadrille ruled)

Journalism Students

*Digital camera

*Software for downloading pictures (to be used at home)

Bible Classes

*NIV Bible – the staff requests that all students use a New International Version Bible so the class will not be distracted by different versions.

P.E. Classes

*All P.E. students must purchase a uniform for class. Students who do not “dress down” will receive a deduction in their P.E. grade. Uniforms will be available at Parents’ Orientation. The cost of the t-shirt will be \$15. The cost of the NBA length shorts will be \$25. If a student chooses to purchase sweat pants, they will cost \$20 per pair.

All 7th-12th Grade Science Students

All 7th-12th grade science students must purchase a pair of splash/impact goggles to be worn during all labs. These goggles can be purchased at Home Depot for approximately \$6.00. All parents will be required to pay a \$50 lab fee for each 7th-12th grade student who takes a science class.

7th-12th Grade Art Students

5”X7” (or larger) Sketchbook

All parents will be required to pay a \$30 art fee for each 7th-12th grade student who takes art class.

7th – 12th Grade Retreat

Typically, students attend a two day retreat during the first month of school. However, in deference to our families who are struggling with the economy, the FCS staff is designing a different September event for our students. We will be sending you more information soon.

7th-12th Grade Sports Fees

In order to rent gymnasiums and fields, pay referees and league fees, all students athletes will be charged a sports fee. Fees are as follows:

1 sport: \$85

2 or more sports: \$160

3 shifts per athlete in gift wrapping booth or \$50 per athlete

All K-6th Grade Students: All elementary students will be required to purchase a field trip "t-shirt". These shirts will help us keep track of all our precious children whenever the class takes a field trip. T-shirts will cost \$12 each and will be available at Parent Orientation. After purchasing the t-shirt, please write your student's name on the inside tag with a permanent marker.

All K-6th Grade Students: The staff requests that all student Bibles be New International Version. It is very distracting to our students when they are trying to use a variety of versions. Thank you for helping us with this.

All K-6th Grade Students – Art Fee: All K – 6th will be charged a \$25 arts/crafts fee. This fee will simply offset the cost of supplies for all the arts and crafts in the classroom. In this way, parents will not be asked to contribute for art or craft supplies throughout the year. ***The art/craft fee is due at Parents' Orientation.***

All 1st-6th Grade Students: Students in 1st-6th grade may drink water in their classroom – and on warm days this is important. However, they may only have water in **clear, plastic water bottles with the snap close top. Each student should have a water bottle with their name written on it with permanent marker.**

- ***Literature Book Fee:** The 5th-6th grade class has a \$30 literature fee to purchase books for the student's participation in literature groups. (Students will mark in these books.)

All 3rd-6th Grade Students: All 3rd-6th grade students must have an FCS planner/organizer. The teachers have selected an excellent student planner, and they will instruct students about its proper use. The planner will also enable teachers to communicate daily with parents about homework. *Planners will be available at Parents' Orientation. The planners will cost \$8 each.*

All K-6th Grade Students - Incentives Fee: Each K-6th Grade teacher maintains an incentives program – prizes rewarding achievement. If you would like for your student to receive these incentives, a fee of \$15 is due at Parent Orientation. *If parents do not pay the fee, the classroom teacher will communicate the student's achievements to the parent so the parent can reward their student at home.*

The Following Items Are NOT Allowed To Be Used At FCS: Any kind of gel pens, any kind of colored pens (except red), any colored paper (only white is permissible), no spiral bound or perforated spiral bound notebooks for homework (teachers may, however, request a spiral bound notebook for journaling purposes only). All homework must be completed on loose leaf notebook paper. Liquid white out is not permitted – only white out tape.

All 3rd-6th Grade Students Sports Fees:

In order to rent gymnasiums and fields, pay referees and league fees, all students athletes will be charged a sports fee. Fees are as follows:

1 sport: \$85

2 or more sports: \$160
